Unfinished Block Size: 11 1/2" x 11 1/2"

## Fabric Requirements for one block:

- 1 – fat quarter yellow fabric
- 1 – red 5" charm square
- 1 – green 5" charm square
- 1 – 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" strip black fabric
- 2 – 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips brown fabric

## Cutting:

### From yellow fabric cut:

- 8 – 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Rectangle A
- 2 – 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" Strips B

### From red charm cut:

- 3 – 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Rectangle C

### From green charm cut:

- 3 – 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Rectangle C

## Sew:

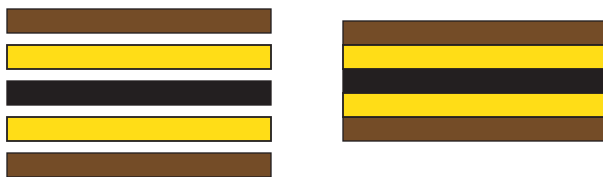
Sew red C's to 4 of the A's:



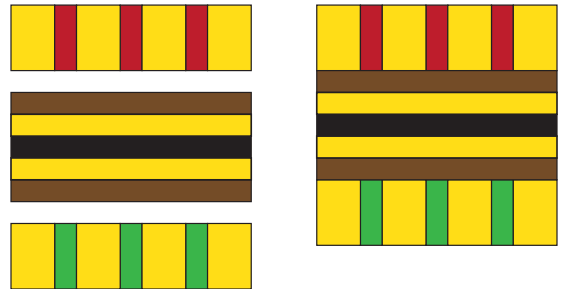
Sew green C's to the remaining A's:



Sew the yellow B strips to the brown and black strips as shown:



Now sew these three sections together...



Pretty easy, huh?

The tribal boldness of this block goes far beyond the holiday of Kwanzaa. Great as a rail fence pattern for a beginner, plenty of play options for an accomplished quilter.
