

Saint Nick's Star

Unfinished Block Size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Fabric Requirements for one block:

- 1 – Fat quarter light fabric
- Assorted green scraps
- Assorted red.
- Assorted black scraps

Cutting:

From light fabric cut:

- 4 – 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Square A
- 2 – 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares cut in half once diagonally to make 4 Triangle B

From green fabric cut:

- 4 – 2" x 12" strips

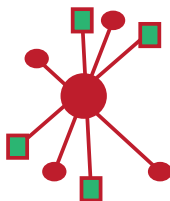


From red fabric cut:

- 2 – 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square C
- 1 – 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" square cut in half twice diagonally to make 4 Triangle D (two will be used in this block, save the other two for another block)

From black fabric cut:

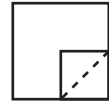
- 2 – 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square C
- 1 – 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" square cut in half twice diagonally to make 4 Triangle D (two will be used in this block, save the other two for another block)



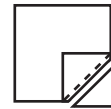
Sew:

Corner Units

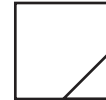
Sew red C to A right sides together as shown:



Cut away excess from both C and A as shown:



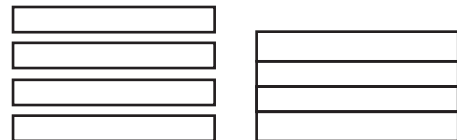
Press C over as shown:



Make 2 of these with the red C's, then repeat process with black C's and remaining A's.

Side Units

Sew 4 green strips together as shown:



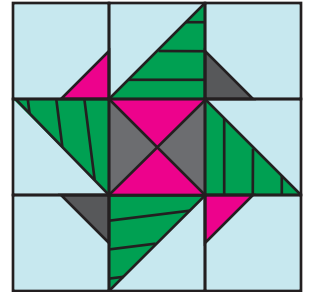
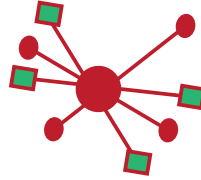
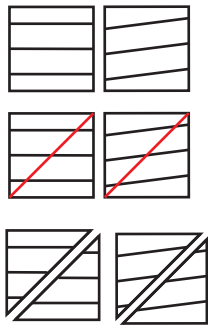
Then cut out two 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares out of the these green strip sets as shown:



(choose to go wonky or straight, there is a bit of play room figured in for this)



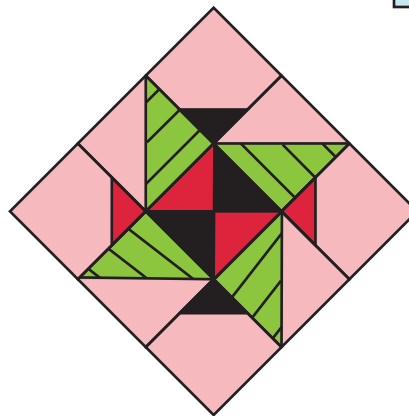
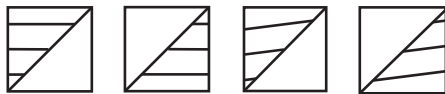
Cut these squares in half once diagonally to make 4 Triangle B1



Sew B and B1 together as shown:

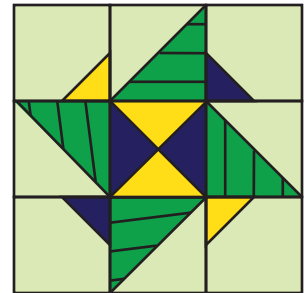
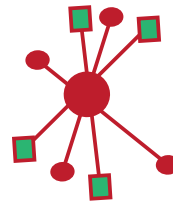
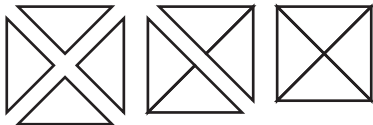


Make 4 of these.
