

Fabric Requirements for one block:
1 - Fat quarter light fabric
Assorted green scraps
Assorted red.
Assorted black scraps

## Cutting:

From light fabric cut:
$4-41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Square A $2-47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut in half once diagonally to make 4 Triangle B

From green fabric cut:
$4-2 " \times 12 "$ strips


From red fabric cut:
$2-2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2$ " Square C
 half twice diagonally to make 4 Triangle D (two will be used in this block, save the other two for another block)

From black fabric cut:
$2-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 21 / 2$ " Square C
 half twice diagonally to make 4 Triangle D (two will be used in this block, save the other two for another block)


## Sew:

## Corner Units

Sew red C to A right sides together as shown:


Cut away excess from both C and A as shown:


Press C over as shown:


Make 2 of these with the red C's, then repeat process with black C's and remaining A's.

## Side Units

Sew 4 green strips together as shown:


Then cut out two $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares out of the these green strip sets as shown:

(choose to go wonky or straight, there is a bit of play room figured in for this)

Cut these squares in half once
diagonally to make 4 Triangle B1


Sew B and B1 together as shown:


Make 4 of these.
$\square$


## Center Unit

Sew black and red D's together as shown:


Sew Corners, Sides, and Center
 as shown:
