



Hang Ups


Supplies:

Quilting Cotton Ribbon or other trim, if desired Thread 12" craft or child's hanger

Sources:

Craft hanger from Michael's Fabric used is Denyse Schmidt's Flea Market Fancy by FreeSpirit

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CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Material	Cut Size	Piece Name	No. Of Pieces
Quilting Cotton	13 1/4" x 12 1/2"	Back	one
	13 1/4" x 4 3/4"	Top Front	one
	13 1/4" x 8 1/4"	Bottom Front	one

NOTE: If hanger is larger than 12" in width, add the difference to the width of each piece (13 1/4" + difference). Also add to the length to facilitate insertion of hanger into opening.

With right sides together align top edges of back and top front. Center hanger across top edge and trace along upper edge of hanger. Also mark 1/4" on either side of where the hook is embedded in the hanger. Cut along traced line.

Place top front and top bottom right sides together. Mark a stitching line starting from each edge and ending two inches from edge. Sew along these lines using a short stitch length. Adjust stitch length to a long stitch and sew between the "x"s. Press seam open.


Topstitch 1/4" along each side of seam. Remove long stitches that secured the center section. If desired, attach ribbon or trim along the topstitching line.

Right sides together, sew front and back together leaving a half inch gap in the top center.

Clip corners and curves. Turn inside out and press.

Insert hanger and you're done!

NOTE: Seam allowances are 3/8" unless otherwise indicated.



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
