

### overall materials:

Scrap of light fabric 5" x 13" or larger  
Scrap of dark/medium fabric 2 ½" x 13" or larger  
Assorted scraps at least 2" wide.

### cutting:

From light fabric:

Cut 2 – 2 ¼" x 12 ½" A Strips

From dark/medium fabric:

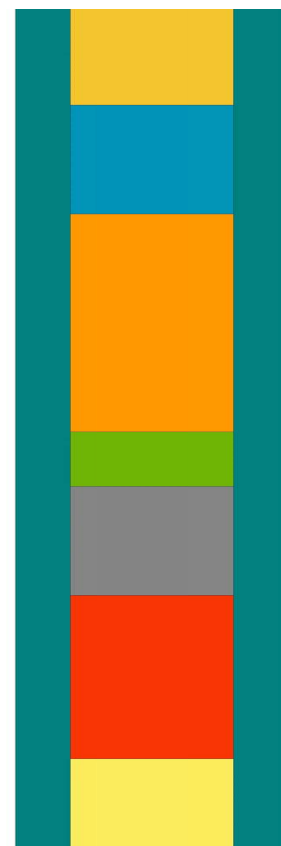
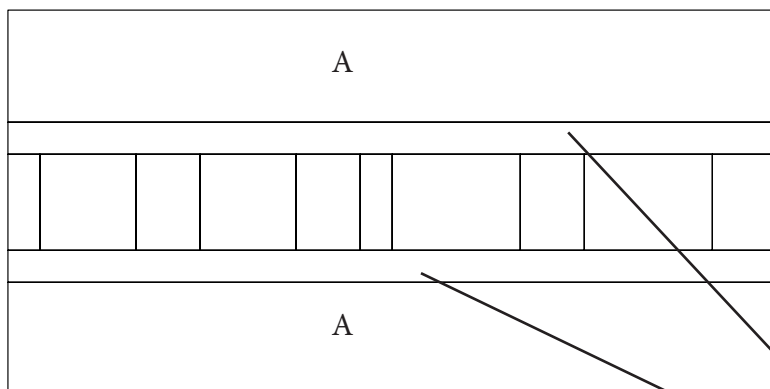
Cut 2 – 1" x 12 ½" B Strips

From assorted scraps:

Cut 2" strips varying from 1" to 3" wide

### putting it together:

1. Sew 2" strips together in a random fashion by sewing the 2" sides together until you get a strip slightly longer than 12 ½" long. Trim to 12 ½".
2. Sew both B Strips to each side of the pieced strip and press away from the center.
3. Sew both A Strips to each side of the unit created in Step 2 and press towards the center.
4. Make a bunch more!
